

NOMINATIONS SOUGHT FOR DOUGLAS P. ZIPES DISTINGUISHED YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD

NOMINATIONS DUE SEPT. 15, 2006

OBJECTIVE

To recognize a young scientist who has made outstanding contributions to the field of cardiovascular disease and who has amassed an impressive body of scientific research in either the clinical or basic domain.

ELIGIBILITY

The recipient must be no more than 5 years out of training from an accredited U.S. institution or comparable international training program.

THE AWARD

The recipient will be invited to present his or her scientific work at the annual Scientific Session of the College. He or she will also be recognized at the annual Convocation of the College and receive a monetary prize of \$1,000. Travel, housing, and registration expenses to attend ACC Scientific Sessions will also be provided.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Nominations are invited from the following:

- o **U.S. and international cardiovascular organizations**
- o **U.S. and international medical schools and/or cardiology departments**

To submit a nomination, the following must be received by **September 15, 2006**:

- **A nominating letter summarizing the curriculum vitae, highlighting those accomplishments that are relevant to the award**
- **Three supporting letters**
- **Nominee's CV**

- **Nominee's list of top 10 (ten) publications**
- **Description of nominee's research interests and professional experience**
